Format – 2024

Scramble Pairs

A new format is being played on Friday – Scramble Pairs!

Playing the 2-Man Scramble

Golfer A and Golfer B form a team. On the tee, both golfers hit drives. They decide which ball is in the best position.

Let's say Golfer B's drive is best. So, Golfer A picks up his ball and moves it to the location of Golfer B's. Placing the moved ball can be done within one club length of the selected ball's position, not closer to the hole. The exception is on the green when they must both putt from the same spot.

Both golfers then play their second strokes from that location. They compare the results of the second strokes and, again, select the ball in the best position. The other golfer moves his or her ball to that location. This method of play continues until the golf ball is holed to record the team score.

Calculating Handicaps in a 2-Person Scramble

The method recommended by the USGA will be used.

- Determine the course handicaps for each player.
- Take 35% of the lower handicap and add it to 15% of the higher handicap.

E.g. Player A's handicap for the course is 8 & Player B's is 21.
 $(35\% \text{ of } 8 = 2.8) + (15\% \text{ of } 21 = 3.15) = 5.95$, so they will play off a 6 handicap.

Tees

On previous tours, everyone has played from the same tees. With the huge range of ages and skill levels on tour, it has been agreed to change this. Each player is free to play off the tee of their choosing (preferably in consultation with their captain). The exception to this is the Friday Scramble Pairs, where each Pair must play off the same tee.



Awards and Prizes

There are several prizes to be won. The first and most important is obviously:

- Team Winners.

There are several prizes for individual play, which will be applicable only to the rounds on Saturday and Sunday.

- Best combined stroke 18 score.
- Best combined stroke 1 score.
- Two closest to the pin on par 3's each day.
- Individual Winner for each day (Stableford points).
- Accumulative Individual Stableford points for Par 3's, Par 4's and Par 5's.
- Overall Individual Winner

And the **Langebaan Challenge!**

The Langebaan Challenge

Hole 1 *Par 4* *358m* *Stroke 1*

With the West Coast's prevailing South Easter wind blowing straight towards you, a tunnel of Manatoka trees as well as a large fairway bunker to the right at the 150m marker, anything off the fairway means getting on for two will prove to be more than a little difficult.

Hole 6 *Par 3* *145m* *Stroke 13*

With 360-degree views of the lagoon and golf course, the 6th hole has a fynbos area, which needs to be cleared before reaching an elevated green. This hole is the highest point of the course, giving you a breathtaking view of the golf course and the whole Estate. Even if you play badly, you still won't be able to suppress a smile at the end of this hole.

Hole 11 *Par 3* *144m* *Stroke 18*

Shaped water features and unique shell waste bunkers on the right of the hole, coupled with a huge green, makes this an easy hole to channel your inner champion and chalk up an impressive score.

Hole 18 *Par 5* *411m* *Stroke 14*

Standing on the tee box of the 18th hole against the backdrop of the recently renovated clubhouse. It could end in tears if you tee off with a driver. Good course management is necessary to finish our challenging 18th hole.
